Jointly organized by National Center for Fruit Development, National Center for Potato, Vegetables and Spice Crops Development and Nepal Horticulture Society; 14<sup>th</sup> National Horticulture Seminar dated 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2024 (Chaitra 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> 2080) with theme of "Unveiling Nepal's Mandarin Orange wealth: From origin to Prosperity" announces interested author(s) to submit relevant papers based on above mentioned theme for presenting at 14<sup>th</sup> National Horticulture Seminar-2024. The author(s) should base the papers on research and development works on Citrus sector.

Interested author(s) are requested to submit the full paper. The Technical Committee deserves final right to accept or reject a submission. The presentation will be published in Compendium titled **Mandarin orange: Science and Technology in Nepal** jointly published by National Center for Fruit Development and Nepal Horticulture Society.

## **Guidelines for Full paper for Oral presentation:**

• The author(s) should firmly follow the guidelines developed by Nepal Horticulture Society, listed on <a href="https://horticulturenepal.org/publication/guide-to-authors">https://horticulturenepal.org/publication/guide-to-authors</a>

## **Guidelines for posters:**

- Posters related to Citrus sector are only accepted.
- The abstract for poster presentation should not exceed more than 250 words
- The poster should provide clear message having different section (Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Result, Conclusion and Reference) in different allocated part for uniformity.
- The poster size should be A0 (33.1"x46.8").
- Use Times New Roman font throughout the text. Poster heading should be in capital letters (font size ≥ 44) and bold. Subheading should be in sentence case (font size ≥ 24). Use minimum font size of 18 points.
- Do not add titles (Dr., PhD, Prof., Scientist etc.) to the authors.
- The name of the authors should not be abbreviated.
- Use at most 3 different colors with text, table, picture and graphs if necessary.
- The presenter should be available in front of the poster on the time of poster presentation
